

Clubhouse Dress Code Policy

Alto Lakes Golf and Country Club Members wish to enjoy the Club's facilities in an environment where all Members follow guidelines of proper attire. At the same time, ALGCC is a premier, full service, family oriented, private country club dedicated to the enjoyment of our Members, their families and Guests. With these goals in mind, please permit the following rules to aid you in determining what attire is proper for ALGCC.

The following items are inappropriate in any section of the Clubhouse, regardless of gender:

- Exposed undergarments, muscle shirts, halter tops, pajamas
- "See-through" fabric without proper lining
- Bare midriffs
- Shorts or skirts with a hemline shorter than mid-thigh
- Clothing with inappropriate print messages in language or design
- Torn, frayed, sloppy or un-tailored clothing and footwear
- Bare feet

Alto 7500 Lounge: Sports Casual

Sports Casual Attire consists of sportswear that is acceptable for sporting activities at the Club, other than the Fitness Center, to include shorts. Flip flops are allowed in the lounge.

Members are encouraged to consider common sense, respect for tradition, modesty, and the comfort level of fellow Members when making sports casual attire dress code decisions.

1st Dining Room: Resort Casual

Resort Casual Attire to include shorts, neatly tailored jeans, and collared shirts. Flip flops are not permitted in the Dining Room.

Children 12 and under will be allowed to wear t-shirts in the dining room.

Small Dining Room: Country Club Casual

After 5:00 PM the Small Dining Room will be restricted to a more formal Country Club Casual attire.

Country Club Casual Attire to include Slacks (including jeans) and collared shirts are required for gentlemen. Ladies are requested to dress in a fashion compatible with the dress required of the men.

Daytime seating in the Small Dining Room will allow shorts until 5:00 PM, but not after.

Children will not be permitted to wear shorts or t-shirts in the Small Dining Room after 5:00 PM.

Gentlemen will be required to remove ballcaps, visors and ski hats after 5:00 PM. Cowboy Hats will be allowed to be worn.

Non Compliance with ALGCC Dress Code will result in a letter from the Board of Directors
